SAND VOLLEYBALL TOURNAMENT

- Compete in one of five divisions.
- All divisions are open gender with no coed rules.
- 4-on-4 teams may have up to 6 players.

DIVISIONS

- 1. Juniors 4-on-4:** Individuals ages 12-18. Subdivisions by age: 12u, 14u, 16u, 18u.
- 2. Adult 4-on-4:** Individuals 18+. Subdivisions: competitive and recreational.
- 3. Collegiate 4-on-4:** Students enrolled in college. *D1 athletes that have remaining college eligibility should check first with their compliance office for approval to participate in this event which benefits Special Olympic Texas.*
- 4. BYOP™ 4-on-4:** Bring Your Own Parent (BYOP)™ teams will include 2 parents and 2 daughters/sons. The BYOP™ program is designed for young athletes 10 under to play with parents on the same team.
- 5. Unified® 6-on-6:** Special Olympics Unified® sports bring together athletes with and without intellectual disabilities to compete on the same team.

REGISTRATION

- **4-on-4:** \$25 per individual (\$100 for a 4-player roster, \$125 for a 5-player roster, \$150 for a 6-player roster)
- **Unified® 6-on-6:** \$100 per team
